What is UNCOMMON?

UNCOMMON is the Youth Ministry under CLF. UNCOMMON is open to all 6th - 12th grade students.

When and Where does UNCOMMON meet?

UNCOMMON meets every Wednesday night from 6:30-8:00pm in the Fellowship Hall at CLF.

What are Squads?

Squads are our version of small groups/lifegroups/discussion groups. Throughout the month at UNCOMMON, students will have the chance to spend time in their Squad to study the bible, engage in meaningful discussion and cultivate healthy community and friendships. Squads are broken down by grade and gender. For example, 6th grade boys will have their own Squad. Each squad is led by one or more of our youth leaders who facilitate the group and intentionally pour into the students.

What Does a Typical Wednesday Night Look Like?

While each week at UNCOMMON may look different, the goal is the same: to create lifelong followers of Jesus and to be a movement of disciple makers. Throughout the course of each month, students will have the opportunity to worship, engage in Bible based teachings, learn how to study scripture, and be immersed in healthy spiritual community. We provide the space for students to ask questions and have some of the best leaders to take that journey with them to discover biblical truths and to equip them to be disciple makers wherever they may go.

As a rough format, we loosely follow a four week cycle. Each month will have a key focus.

Example Focus: Spiritual Rhythms and Disciplines

Week 1: Worship, Teaching on Topic, Communion, Response Time

Week 2: Worship, Split into Squads for Bible Study

Week 3: Worship, Q&A on Monthly Topic

Week 4: Worship, Split into Squads
